I cannot watch videos in prison but I have read the comments you made. What I noted in particular was your profound optimism for my future, and your belief – which I share – that greater dialogue between the EU and Russia will inevitably lead to change.

Your interest in my case and my welfare both touches and rejuvenates me. It strengthens my resolve to continue my struggle – because my struggle is Russia's struggle.

Thank you again for your kindness and thoughtfulness. I wish you every success in the future and I hope we will have a chance to meet in due course.
